

National Identity Cards

- Obtaining of National Identity Cards under Ordinary Service

- The application should be obtained from the Grama Niladhari of the relevant area.
- The original copy of the birth certificate is compulsory and a certified copy of the birth certificate should be submitted along with the application.
- A copy of the complaint made to the police station should be submitted in connection with lot N.I.C.
- Written evidence to confirm that the identity card was used before
- Five photographs
- Identity cards could be obtained on completion of 15 years, if age is over 17 years liable to a Rs 250/= fine .
- If the age is less than 15 years a stamp worth of Rs.3 / -, if the age is over 15 years a stamp worth of s Rs.15 / - and 9x4 envelop affixed stamps worth of Rs.35
- For amendments previous N.I.C should be submitted.
- The officer of the Divisional Secretariat will submit the application for N.I.C. for the Dept of Registration of Persons and you will receive the completed N.I.C by post.

- Obtaining of National Identity Cards under one day service

- The original copy of the birth certificate is compulsory for obtaining an identity card under one day service and all other documents are required except an envelope affixed Rs .35 stamp.
